

City of Henrietta Street Department

Data:

Currently, the City of Henrietta contains 50.35 miles of streets and highways within the city limits and an additional 19.4 miles of streets and highways within its ETJ, for a total of 69.75 miles. Of this total, the City is responsible for the operation and maintenance of 35.16 miles, while Clay County and TxDOT are responsible for the operation and maintenance of the remaining 15.19 miles.

Major Projects for 2009

1. 2009 Seal Coat: The Street Department will begin in April to zip, reclaim, and rebuild streets located mainly in the Northern part of the City. For further detail look at 2009 Seal Coat List on the main Street page.
2. Replacing Old Street Signs: The department is focusing on replacing older signs, and adding signage to intersections not marked in the City. They will mark these new street name signs on highly visible areas first and work their way through the City. This project may take more than a year to complete.
3. Assisting Park Department with Park Grant project and Henrietta City Park: The City was awarded a grant to make repairs to the swimming pool and to add features to the park. The Street department will add a butterfly garden, game tables and install workout stations near the new walking park.
4. Assistance code enforcement with dilapidated houses and cleanups: The Street department will tear down dilapidated houses for the City.
